

Work has started on upgrading the lighting in the churchyard. When this project is complete (which is anticipated as late November or early December) the area from the bottom gates to the top gates and the path to The Tree House should all be covered by lighting which will be triggered by movement sensors.

It is hoped that work on resurfacing the pathway through the churchyard will go ahead in January. A Faculty has been applied for and we are awaiting the outcome.

White Waltham Church remains in a tricky financial position. The latest accounts showed that giving has increased slightly which is very positive. The PCC has a finance sub committee which is monitoring costs very closely and looking at ways in which income can be increased.

The Future of the Parishes is still undecided. The Diocese is currently considering an alternative scheme to address the concerns of the Church Commissioners but no further news on this was available to the PCC at the time of their meeting.

The parking in Grove Park will again be used for the Cox Green Christmas Concert on Monday 19th December and the Candlelit Carol Service on Christmas Eve.
